DAVID OLSON teaches patent law, IP, antitrust and various seminars. His research primarily focuses on patents, copyrights, antitrust, and incentives for innovation and competition. He has been recognized for his teaching excellence, including with the Business & Law Society Faculty Award for Achievement in Business & Law, and the Professor Emil Slizewski Award for Faculty Excellence. Professor Olson has lectured around the world, including at Zhongyuan Technical University, Zhengzhou, China, and as a visiting professor at Pontifical Catholic University, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. Professor Olson's scholarship has been cited in U.S. Supreme Court and other legal opinions. He has testified before the U.S. Congress on drug patents, FDA regulation and antitrust, and has been quoted in *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Associated Press* and *Reuters*, among others. Before academia, Professor Olson was a patent litigator.
