BERNARDO C. He is a Senior Director at the Mass General Brigham (MGB) Data Science Office and leads its Digital Clinical Research Organization (CRO). Dr. Bizzo is a Senior Scientist at the American College of Radiology (ACR) Data Science Institute and a member of the ACR's Commission on Informatics. His work focuses on developing, validating and implementing AI solutions. Dr. Bizzo has led the development of several clinical AI applications over the past seven years, collaborating with MGB clinicians, investigators and industry partners. In the past three years, he and his team at the Digital CRO have led the design and conduct of clinical investigations to support numerous successful FDA clearances of AI products. He also oversees the clinical implementation of imaging and predictive AI solutions across MGB.
