

Charlie Glassenberg is Vice President, Gift Planning & Investment Partnerships, at Combined Jewish Philanthropies (CJP), Boston's Jewish federation. Charlie focuses on integrating planned giving into CJP's overall development program and on growing CJP's Donor Advised Fund program, which serves nearly 700 individuals and families and has over \$900 million in philanthropic capital. He also serves as liaison for CJP's Jewish Community Endowment Pool, LLP (JCEP), which manages over \$1.4 billion in endowment assets from over eighty Jewish community organizations, and staffs four committees overseeing CJP's investment programs and gift acceptance policies. Prior to joining CJP in 2008, Charlie was Director of Planned Giving and Director of Development Operations at Hebrew SeniorLife in Boston. He is a graduate of Amherst College and Johns Hopkins University, and received a Certificate in Financial Planning from Boston University. Charlie is a former member of the Executive Board of the Planned Giving Group of New England, Co-Chair of the School Committee and past Trustee of Temple Emanuel in Newton Centre, and an active volunteer fundraiser for Amherst College.
